Atlantic Women's Conference update

The Atlantic Women's Conference will be held June 3-5 at St FX, in Antigonish. A Domestic Violence forum took place in December of 2016. A domestic violence workshop is being developed and will be a big part of Women's Conference.

Robyn Benson, Maria Fitzpatrick, MLA, is two of the suggested speakers. A panel will be organized as well. Andree cote will be invited to facilitate the workshop on domestic violence. We are hoping to have the "Park Bench Players" provide entertainment on Saturday night. A discussion followed on our theme. Suggestions were provided.

We are hoping to have 100-120 participants with a budget of \$96,652.

Child Care
