The TRUE facts on Public Service Benefits

Stop the misinformation about civil servants:

- ✓ Public sector workers do not abuse sick days; statistics Canada data and reports from the Parliamentary Budget Officer (PBO) conclude that federal employees do not take more sick days than workers in the private sector (most federal workers take between 0 to 8 days in sick leave per year, not 18).
- ✓ The average annual pension received by retired federal public sector worker is \$27,380, whereas the average annual pension for a Member of Parliament is \$67,461 (taxpayers contribute nearly \$6 into the pension plan for every \$1 contributed by Members of Parliament).
- ✓ Public servants deliver essential services to ALL Canadians: E.I., OAS, CPP, Veterans, Tax services, food inspection, transportation inspection, etc.
