This training is a must for stewards and other workplace representatives, or members who want to solve problems at the workplace. You will find out what the law says about grievances, grievers and their representatives, and the protections built in for those who choose to use the grievance procedure to solve problems. You will develop:

- grievance handling
- problem solving skills through "hands-on" exercises on gathering facts and resources
- analyzing a problem
- drafting grievance wording
- building a complete file, and presenting the case to the employer. You will work with case studies based on actual grievances, and in the process, improve your knowledge of case law.

What is covered:

- ► Members will receive a \$50 per diem.
- ► Loss of salary (where applicable) will be reimbursed.

 Members who work weekends or evenings must provide a shift schedule.
- ► Family care will be reimbursed as per the PSAC policy on family care.
