"The Harper government made draconian cuts to public services affecting ALL Canadians," says Jeannie Baldwin, Regional Executive Vice-President, "We will fight back to protect those services, uphold our rights as union members and ensure that we are ready to defeat the Harper government in 2015."

The Convention will be addressed by PSAC National President Robyn Benson and Regional Executive Vice-President Jeannie Baldwin. Professional comedian, actor, writer and speaker Candy Palmater will deliver the keynote.

With a membership of over 170,000, PSAC is one of the largest unions in the country. PSAC represents over 18,000 workers in the Atlantic primarily in the federal public sector.
